We are seeking students eager to broaden their minds, to cross boundaries and to achieve new goals beyond the ordinary. If graduates are interested in our New Media programme, financial restraints, however, should not hamper them to apply. Therefore, we set up different scholarships depending on academic performance and/or financial need.

- tuition scholarship awarded by ISNM

- stipend (e.g., DAAD or of your own country).
